Topic words	
Transport	A vehicle, aircraft or ship that can carry people or goods from one place to another.
United Kingdom	The United Kingdom is made up of Northern Ireland, Scotland, Wales and England.
Landmarks	An object or feature of a landscape or town that is easily seen and recognised from a distance, especially one that enables someone to establish their location.
Solar system	The solar system includes the Sun and all the objects that orbit around it due to its gravity, including Earth.
Planets	A planet is an object orbiting a star that is large enough to be rounded by its own gravity. There are eight planets in the Solar System
