Past (then)	Refers to something that has happened before and up until the present day
Present (now)	What is happening now?
Vet	A vet is someone who medically treats poorly animals.
Doctor	Doctors are people who practice medicine. Doctors are trained to keep people healthy and to help the sick.
Nurse	A nurse is a person who is trained to give care (help) to people who are sick or injured
Firefighter	Firefighters are people whose job is to put out fires and rescue people.
Police	A police officer is a serving member of a police force. Police officers arrest criminals, prevent crime, protect and help the public, and keep public order.
