Summary of PPG spending 2018/19

In our school we used this funding to:

- Provide additional hours for a teaching assistant to deliver bespoke interventions which included alphabet arc work, precision teaching and Talking Partners.
- Provide TA hours to deliver SaLT activities.
- Fund after school clubs, school trips, uniform and residential trip for target pupil.

Summary of spending:

- £2000—towards additional teaching assistant hours.
- £640— school trips, after school clubs, violin tuition and residential.

Impact of spending:

- The pupil receiving the bespoke intervention programmes has made significant progress. Target pupil finished the year with a reading age that was in line with chronological age from a starting point of 2 years 3 months below.
- Speech and language activities are continuing.
- Interventions being delivered to pupils that include alphabet arc work, precision teaching exercises, phonic games and daily reading have ensured rapid progress which enabled those pupils to pass the phonics screening test.

Summary of PPG proposed spending 2019/20

- Provide TA hours to deliver a bespoke intervention to two pupils and to carry out Word Wasp, Toe-by-Toe, Talking Partners and Precision Teaching interventions to a further two pupils.
- The impact of this additional 1:1 and/or small group support will be measured by pupils' reading and maths ages being in line or above chronological age.
- Fund school trips, uniform and violin tuition.
