

Pupil Premium 2015/2016

Pupil Premium is an amount of Government money provided to raise education standards and opportunities for disadvantaged children. The amount of funding that schools receive is based upon the number of children who are registered for free school meals on the school census date and also children of parents in the armed services. It is a requirement that schools publish how this funding is spent.

Curriculum focus of PPG spending

Dependent upon the needs of the child – numeracy and literacy

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

Progress of all children is monitored at least half termly as appropriate to ensure progress is made
