Mathematics

Throughout this term the children will;

- Match and sort
- Compare size, mass and capacity
- Explore 2D shapes and patterns
- Positional language
- Recognise, represent and compare numbers to 10

Physical development

The children will explore different equipment in PE, developing skills in sending and receiving balls of different sizes. The children will continue to develop gross motor skills through participation in outdoor play, bikes and scooters as well as through movement when listening to music.

The children will be given opportunities to develop their fine motor skills, specifically pencil and scissor control.

The children will be looking at how we grow and keep our bodies healthy.

Communication, language and literacy

During this term, the children will listen to and explore stories linked to our topic. The children will use circle time to further develop their own language skills.

The children will participate in daily phonics activities. They will be encouraged to listen carefully in all their reading and writing activities.

Guided reading in small groups will take place each week

During our writing sessions we will be sequencing, writing lists, information sheets and developing our descriptive language.

Personal, social and emotional development

The children will develop their skills of being a good friend and they will be encouraged to consider other children's feelings throughout everyday activities.
