Amount of Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) received: £3,900

We have used this funding to:

- Provide small group intervention with experienced teaching assistant, using memory game cards to develop pupils short term memory skills.
- Support FSM pupils participation in after school activities run by outside companies
- Provide small group intervention and friendship groups allowing for work on raising the well-being and self- esteem of targeted pupils.
- Provided one to one support for children carried out by qualified teaching assistants focusing on the needs of individuals across all aspects of school life both academic and social.
- Provide supply/extra time for staff to attend training in intervention programmes - ELKAN Speech and Language support programme.
