Summary of PPG spending 2017/18

In our school we used this funding to:

- Provide additional hours for a teaching assistant to deliver bespoke interventions which included alphabet arc work, precision teaching and phonics based activities.
- Provide TA hours to deliver ongoing Speech and Language support activities.
- Fund after school clubs and school trips for target pupils.

Summary of spending:

- £2000—towards additional teaching assistant hours.
- £640— school trips, after school clubs and violin tuition.

Impact of spending:

- The pupil receiving the bespoke intervention programmes have made significant progress. Target pupil has made better than expected progress by ending the year as exceeding from an emerging starting point.
- Speech and language support is ongoing but significant progress is being made.
- Interventions being delivered to pupils that include alphabet arc work, precision teaching exercises, phonic games and daily reading have ensured rapid progress which has resulted in 100% pass rate for the phonics screening test.

Summary of PPG proposed spending 2018/19

- Provide TA hours to deliver a bespoke intervention to one pupil and to carry out Word Wasp, Toe-by-Toe and Precision Teaching interventions to a further four pupils.
- The impact of this additional 1:1 and/or small group support will be measured by pupils' reading ages being in line or above chronological age and the phonics screening test pass %.
- School trips and visits funded by school for target pupil.
