Nature of support provided

- Teaching assistant support for small group intervention.
 - These are groups where literacy or numeracy skills are developed through programmes designed to support the needs of children performing either just below average standards for that age group or ones that are clearly exceeding these expectations. The children are provided with support to develop those skills.
 - Small group intervention allows for work on raising the well-being and self-esteem of pupils.
- One to one support for children.
 - This is carried out by suitably qualified teaching assistants.
 - Focus is on the needs of individuals across all aspects of school life both academic and social.
- Support for extra-curricular activities
 - Funds used to ensure all children have access to all activities on offer in school.

Curriculum focus of PPG spending

- Varied according to the needs of the child

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

- Progress of all children is monitored at least termly through Pupil Progress Meetings where needs and intervention are identified or reviewed, and end of year results are monitored to ensure progress has been made.
